





Comments: COC Flash Point is abnormally low.










Elemental analysis results (above) in parts per million (ppm). [10,000 ppm = 1.0%]

05/25/23	Flash point has recovered more. Continue to vent the expansion tank to reduce low boilers. Resample at next interval to monitor. COC Flash Point is abnormally low.
10/19/22	Flash point has recovered more. Continue to vent the expansion tank to reduce low boilers. Resample at next interval to monitor. COC Flash Point is abnormally low.
05/17/22	Flash point has recovered somewhat. Continue to vent the expansion tank to reduce low boilers. Resample at next interval to monitor. COC Flash Point is severely low.
02/03/22	Flash point redone. Although the parameters of the HTF are very constant during the last year the flash point has dropped and is still abnormally low. Levels of low weight hydrocarbons recommend to monitor the low boilers and continue to perform venting, that may help to recover the flash point. COC Flash Point is severely low.
