Comments: Wear metals/contamination are nil. Water ppm of 18 and extremely low acid number are very good results. Viscosity is in satisfactory range. COC Flash point satisfactory at 238oC. Pentane insolubles have dropped to great levels of .039; appearance of the fluid sample is GOOD.
